3. Lien Claimants will not challenge the dismissal of any liens dismissed under Labor Code §4903.05 [which liens were omitted from list of liens under Consolidation Order and this stipulation based on the prior dismissal].
4. There are no remaining issues pending in the special lien proceeding under Labor Code section §139.21.


